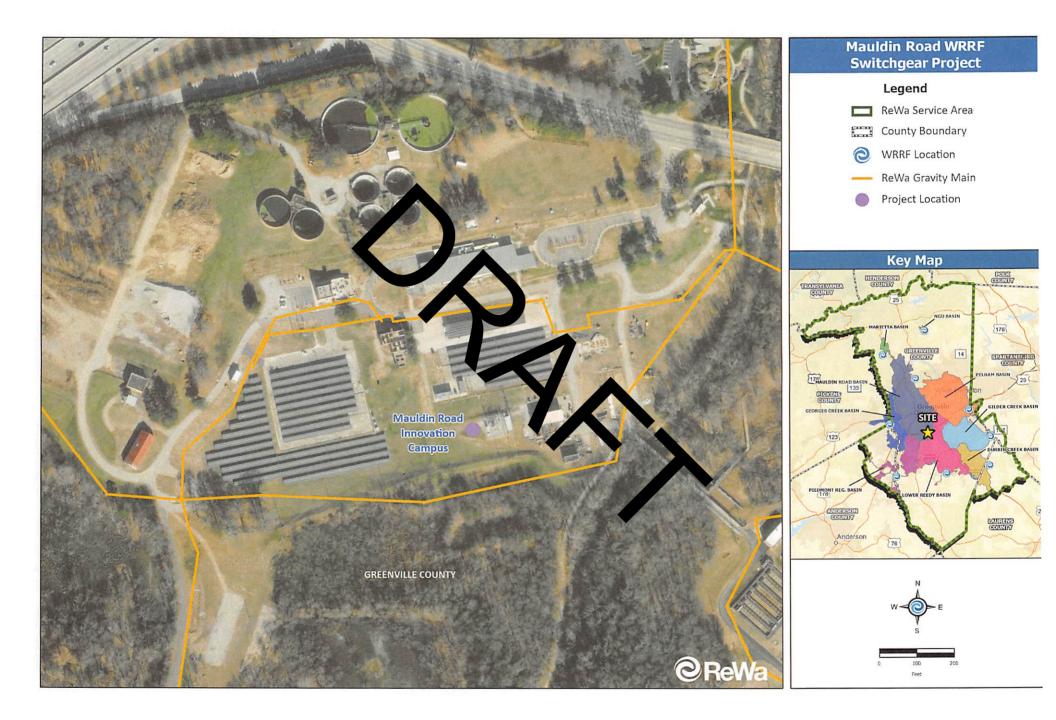

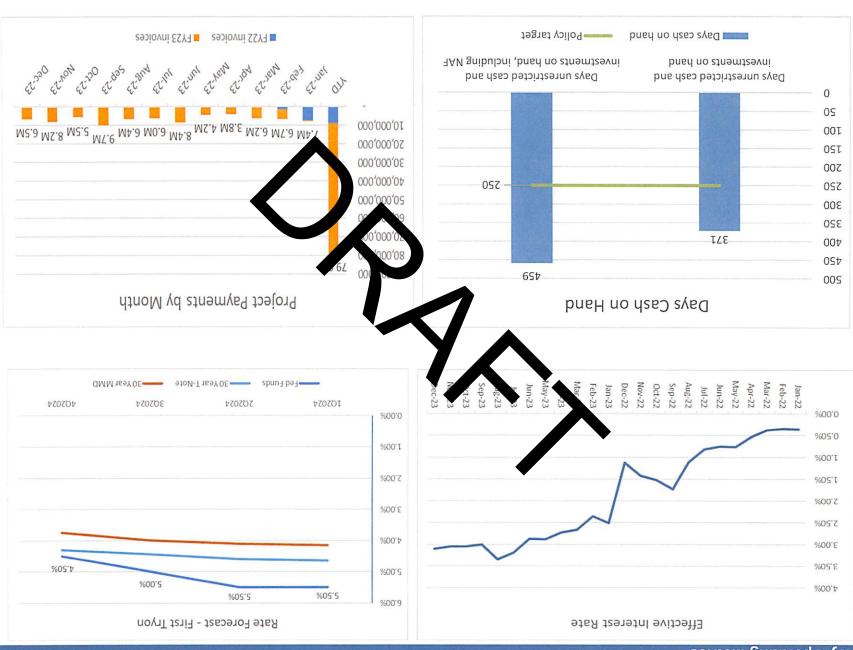

WHEREAS, Renewable Water Resources (ReWa) is committed to maintaining fair and equitable user fees for all customer classes including both existing and future customers;

WHEREAS, ReWa supports a philosophy that growth pays for growth;

WHEREAS, Staff has reviewed the current New Account Fee and Capital Contribution Fee Methodologies; and

WHEREAS, a New Account Fee Study has been conducted by Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc.,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DESOLVED that Renewable Water Resources does hereby rescind the Residentia and Connercial Capital Contribution Policy dated May 2021, while amending the New Account files Streduc, Resolution dated February 2001 and the Rate Increase on New Account Fees any ulti-family and mixed-use) dated April 2017 with the following:

- The capital contribution methodology has been combined/absorbed into the New Account Fee methodology,
- The effective date of this Recolution will be July 1, 2024;
- The New Account Fee will be compared before ReWa's issuance of the Flow Acceptance Letter (capacity reservation);
- If a capital contribution fee has been p.d, then we Account Fee will remain at \$2,500 until December 31, 2025; and
- The Trunk and Treatment New Account Fees are as follow
